

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

In accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), any information recorded about your child is that which can assist in a student's personal, social academic, and vocational development. All of your child's records will be kept confidential by the Tate County Schools and will be provided to other agencies only in accord with FERPA. No unauthorized person may see your Child's records unless you give your Consent in writing. Before Information in your child's folder is to be destroyed, you will be given the opportunity to get a copy of this information.

You or your representative may see Your child's records which relate to Referral, identification, evaluation, and Educational placement. We will be Glad to explain any of the results that you may have questions about. We will ask for your permission in writing before testing is done and, should placement into gifted program be deemed appropriate. You may give your consent, refuse to give consent, or change your mind and withdraw consent at any time.
